#### **INDIA'S TRADE PERFORMANCE**




Merchandise Exports touched US \$ 302.8 billion and rebounded with a growth of 9.78% in 2017-18 vis-a-vis 2016-17.



n 2017-18 (Apr-Feb) Services Exports contributed US \$ 175.3 billion and Imports remained at US \$ 105.7 billion, leaving a surplus of US \$ 69.7 billion

#### Export (Quality Control & Inspection) Act, 1963

#### **EIC** is a Competent Authority for Export Certification

- Tech Competent for Q.C, Insp. & Certification
- Powers to obtain information from exporter
- Powers to enter and inspect
- Power to take legal Action

- Powers to search
- Powers to seize commodities / conveyances
- Delegation of powers
- Powers to make Rules



## Use of International standards by EIC

- <u>Inspection</u>: Required Accreditation as per ISO:17020 (Inspection Agencies)
- **Testing**: Required Accreditation as per ISO: 17025 (Testing and Calibration Labs)
- **Certification**: Required Accredited Certification as per ISO: 22000/HACCP, 9001, 14001 etc. (Industry)






