Purpose

ILSI-India is an entity of the International Life Sciences Institute (ILSI), headquartered in Washington DC., USA. ILSI India provides scientific inputs and secretariat assistance to the South Asian Region, which includes Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka. It has headquarters in New Delhi.

ILSI India design programs to foster multi-sector collaboration for conducting, summarizing, and disseminating science related to most pressing health issues in the region. ILSI strategy encourages global action on identifying and then resolving outstanding scientific questions in four thematic areas that capture the core of ILSI's work: four thematic areas that capture the core of ILSI India's work:

Food Safety, Risk Science and Toxicology, Nutrition and Health, Sustainable Agriculture and Nutrition Security

These focus areas provide structure for responding to and raising awareness of the pressing issues society faces. They also help elucidate new opportunities for driving scientific progress. ***ILSI India's work is guided by its Code of Ethics, Scientific Integrity and Organizational Standards of Conduct.***

The purpose of launching these Awards is to encourage research scholars and young scientists to achieve excellence in research relating to food safety and nutrition for improving public health. ILSI India is pleased to announce Awards in the following categories.

1. ILSI India Research Scholar Awards

The Award will be given in following fields: **Nutrition/ Food Technology/ Food Safety/ Risk Assessment/ Technology for Enhancing Food and Nutrition Security**. The research work should relate to improvement in Public Health. This will be given to young scholars who have completed at least 3 years in Ph.D / completed Ph.D.

Eligibility

The candidate should be from a recognized National Institute / University. Age limit is 27 years. The candidate must have published few papers in reputed peer reviewed journals.

Selection Procedure

ILSI India Selection Committee including Senior Scientists will review the applications and shortlist candidates for short interviews and announce the Awards in March first week.

The Award

There will be 4 Awards . A citation will be given along with INR 30,000 in cash.

The successful Awardees will get an opportunity to participate in ILSI India Annual Meeting / Other Conferences and present their paper. They will have the opportunity to meet government, industry and other researchers.

Nomination Procedure

The candidate should be from a National Institute / University and should be nominated by the Research Guide and endorsed by the Head of the Department in case the Research Guide is not the Head of the Department.

2. ILSI India Young Scientist Awards

This Award will be given to young scientist below 45 years of age who has made outstanding research contribution in area of: **Food Safety / Toxicology /Nutrition/ Nutrition and Gut Microbiome/ Indigenous Food and Role in Chronic Inflammation.**

Eligibility

The Applicant / Nominee should hold full time appointment at recognized academic institution and at least five years of academic experience after receiving a terminal degree and not more than ten years.

The Award

There will be 2 Awards. The Award includes a citation and Rs 50,000 in cash.

The successful Awardees will get an opportunity to participate in ILSI India Annual Meeting / Other Conferences and present their paper. They will have the opportunity to meet government, industry and other researchers.

Nomination Procedure

Nomination can be made by Vice Chancellors of Universities, Director of Institutes, Principals of Higher Education Institutes and Dean of Faculties. If an Applicant applies directly then He / She will be required to get the Application approved by one of the aforementioned person.
